# OVERLOOKED FALL FISHING MY FAVORITES

- 1. Cisco/Whitefish
- 2. Lake Trout/Splake
- 3. Steelhead
- 4. Pike





#### Cisco/Whitefish

- 1. Look for lakes with deep (40' +) water
- 2. Easy to find on sonar-large schools
- 3. Fall is spawning time! Shallow gravel
- 4. Jigs with plastics and/or live bait
- 5. Jigging spoons/Glide baits





#### Lake Trout/Splake

- 1. Look for lakes with deep (40' +) water
- 2. Planted in a lot of smaller inland lakes
- 3. Will be on deep structure or cruising flats
- 4. Fall spawners on shallow gravel (cisco)
- 5. Jigs and plastics/Spoons/Crankbaits





# OVERLOOKED FALL FISHING Steelhead

- 1. Great Lakes bays, streams and marinas
- 2. Boat fishing, wading, bank fishing
- 3. May be hard to find uncrowded places
- 4. Floats with bait, beads, spawn
- 5. Casting jigs, crankbaits, spoons, spinners





#### **Northern Pike**

- 1. Best time of year for a trophy!
- 2. Best fishing is lakes with deep water bait
- 3. Inside corners and shallow rock structure
- 4. Big Crankbaits, Jigs/plastics, spoons
- 5. Dead bait
