

### Handlining

#### HAND LINING


Although there are many methods and setups, shown below is a typical setup for hand line trolling.

Many anglers prefer to experiment with different combinations to see what works best for them.



← CURRENT FLOW

Rule of thumb: Each foot of leader length equals 1" of drop. For example, a 20' leader with a typical walleye river spoon will drop 20".



Remember that fish tend to be 8-10" higher at night, so be sure to compensate with leader height.

1-1/2 mph or slower is a good starting speed.
